- 300-word statement describing anticipated course of study within the Jewish and Israel Studies Program and objectives within and beyond the academy. Please type and attach to application.
- Undergraduate students: written commitment to earn a minor or certificate in Jewish and Israel Studies
- Graduate students: evidence that thesis or dissertation is in area of Jewish and Israel Studies. One letter of recommendation required.
