This course examines the Holocaust – the systematic mass murder of Europe's Jews and other groups that did not fit the Nazi racial order including homosexuals, Roma and Sinti, and the handicapped. The course focuses on illuminating the evolution of Nazi policies from the state-sanctioned discrimination to genocide by close reading of primary sources such as victim diaries, memoirs, and interviews.
